- 2. PC70 Plus Individuals only** – open to members 14 years and over on 1st January 2025
To be jumped in conjunction with Class 1
- 3. PC80 Teams and Individuals** – 1st round Table A, 2nd round Single phase
- 4. PC90 Teams and Individuals** – Table A
- 5. PC100 Teams and Individuals** – Table A
- 6. PC110 Teams and Individuals** – Table A
As per the new rule, the distances for doubles and combinations will be adjusted for ponies 148cm and below. Please make sure when entering you enter the correct section height.

AWARDS

Rosettes will be awarded in all classes as follows:

Teams to 6th place.

Individuals to 8th place

Area Trophies to winning individual and team

NB. The organisers reserve the right to increase/decrease the number of rosettes/prizes awarded in ratio to the entries per class and will be announced at the beginning of the class.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY AND GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Classes will be judged under: [PC Show Jumping Rulebook 2026](#)
2. **Withdrawals** up to midnight of 1st July will be refunded in full less a £5 administration charge. Withdrawals on 2nd July or beyond there will be no refund.
3. **The Judge's decision is final.**
4. Any objections must be made by the DC/Centre Proprietor or their representative as per the Show Jumping Rulebook 2026.
5. **Times & running orders** will be posted on **Pony Club results** for each class.
6. Well behaved dogs are welcome on leads, you must clean up after your dog.
7. **Hard hats** to the current Pony Club standard **MUST** be worn at all times when mounted.
8. There will be no Tack and Turnout competition. Whilst there will be stewards carrying out tack checks in each collecting ring, it is the competitor's responsibility to ensure all tack and dress rules are followed.
9. **Health and Safety** Organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all the officials and stewards.
